

Crestwood School Remote Learning Grading Policy

Students who have chosen remote learning will be graded using the Crestwood School grading policy as shown below.

Grading Scale

A 100%-93%

B 92%-85%

C 84%-78%

D 77%-70%

F 69%-0%

If students are completing the paper/pencil option for remote learning, completed assignments must be turned in each Friday. The assignments for the upcoming week will be picked up at this time as well.

If students are completing the online Edgenuity option, assignments should be completed NO LATER than the following Wednesday. Students have from Monday to the following Wednesday to complete all assignments listed on the weekly plans. (Weekly lesson plans can be found at <http://pariscrestwoodremotlearning.weebly.com/>)

If students do not return their paper/pencil work or complete their assignments on Edgenuity by the following Wednesday, they will receive a **ZERO** for the incomplete assignment(s).

Attendance Policy: Students should be logging into Edgenuity daily to complete the weekly assignments. If students have not logged into Edgenuity for two consecutive school days, a phone call will be made. Per ISBE guidelines, students need to receive 5 hours of instruction daily (this includes Edgenuity, iReady, OneNote, Teams, Art, PE, Music, etc).

- Encourage all members to participate in chat.
- Encourage class to stay on topic.

Stand Tall, Be Proud

- "Stop, Leave, Talk" when disrespect is heard on video.
